Featured Speaker **David Hume Kennerly**

David Hume Kennerly has been photographing history for four decades. Contributing Editor for Newsweek Magazine, Kennerly continues to travel the globe to produce insightful images of important historic events.

Kennerly won the Pulitzer Prize for Feature Photography in 1972 for his remarkable photographs of the Vietnam war. After the war, Kennerly returned to the United States for Time Magazine, and in mid-1973 and threw himself into the domestic battles then raging in Washington. After Richard Nixon resigned, Kennerly was on the South Lawn of the White House as the soon-to-be ex-President departed. His historic photo of Nixon's wave goodbye, taken when Kennerly was just 27 years old, is one of the dozens of his images that have helped define American photojournalism.

Nixon's successor, President Gerald Ford, asked Kennerly to serve as his White House Photographer, a role that resulted in some of the most personal political pictures of his career. During Ford's tenure, Kennerly photographed world leaders including Emperor Hirohito in Japan, Leonid Brezhnev in the USSR, Franco in Spain, Ceausescu in Romania, Marcos in the Philippines, Tito in Yugoslavia, Suharto in Indonesia, Deng Xiao Ping in the People's Republic of China, and Queen Elizabeth during the bicentennial celebration at the White House.

In the year 2000, Kennerly traveled more than 250,000 miles to 38 states and seven countries for his fourth book, Photo du Jour: A Picture-A-Day Journey through the First Year of the New Millennium, published in October 2002 by the University of Texas Press. A companion exhibition of fine art prints from Photo du Jour appeared at the Smithsonian Institution's Arts and Industries Building from October 1, 2002-December 29, 2002, and at the Houston Center for Photography April 30 - June 12, 2004.

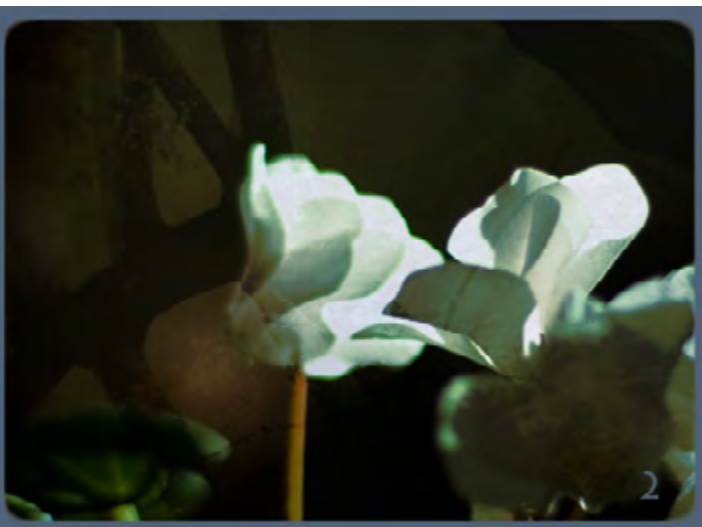

OCC member Christian Mildh, illustrator, designer and photographer, will give a talk about the art of image sequences, specifically diptychs. The presentation will not be centered on the “how” but on the “why” of the process, showing a variety of possible image pairings, exploring implications in mood, style and message...encouraging photographers who are new to this format to give it a try.

A diptych is a pair of images in juxtaposition, mainly side by side or stacked, with a specific relationship and/or interaction between them.

Through analogies, associations, repetitions or shifts of vantage point, diptychs can enhance interaction, communicate ideas and amplify emotions. An image pairing is a simple way to strengthen a story, enhance a moment, or give a different perspective on a theme. What is interesting about diptychs, is their ability to create ambiguous feelings and to puzzle the audience who will tend to decipher the relationship between the component parts.

MEMBERSHIP RENEWALS

First let me explain how you can upgrade to Family Host.

Go to the club website and log in with your user name and password. Then go to the Member Area Menu and select Update My Account Information. If you are upgrading to Family Host you will complete the fields Family Member Name, email address and phone for each family member that will be added under your Family Member Host. When you complete this information be sure to click on the Green Button SAVE PROFILE.

Next you will go back to Member Area and once again click on Update My Account Information. This time you will click on the green word Subscriptions. This will take you to the renew my subscription (membership). And on this screen you will select Renew and Change My Plan to Family Host. This will take you to the payment screen and you will pay as normal.

Please note that several are based on limited quantities and I cannot issue rain checks. As always, UPS Ground shipping is FREE in the Lower 48 and there is no sales tax except for orders shipped to MA, RI or ME. By now I'm sure you have heard that Canon will announce the 5D Mark IV, probably on Thursday August 25. As I am writing this and sending it prior to 8/25, I still don't have exact pricing, or know exact specifications yet. Rumor has it that it will have 30.4 effective megapixels, shoot 7 fps, have 4k video, a faster processor, more focusing points and higher iso than the 5D MK III and a host of other upgrades and features!
