## November Shoot-Out - Orlando Wetlands Park

Join co-host, Kathy Bargar and me for a morning of nature photography. This will be the perfect time to create images for the December OCC Competition with the theme being NATURE.

The Orlando Wetlands Park has more than 20 miles of roads and woodland trails leading through marshes, hardwood hammocks and along scenic lakes. The open waters of the lake and marshes attract wintering waterfowl, wood storks, white ibis, black-crowned night herons, and other wading birds are common during the cooler months. Bald eagles, limpkins, and red-shouldered hawks, black vultures, and turkey vultures are year round residents in the Orlando Wetlands Park. Raccoons, river otters, white-tailed deer and bobcats can be seen along the roads and hiking trails.

The park opens at sunrise. All paths are foot-traffic only. They recommend you bring hiking shoes, a hat, binoculars, camera, snacks, drinking water, sunscreen and insect repellent. There are free Tram Tours on Saturdays, first-come first-served basis.

Park entrance is free. Please go to their website to view directions, a map of the wetlands, birding guide and more information about the park.

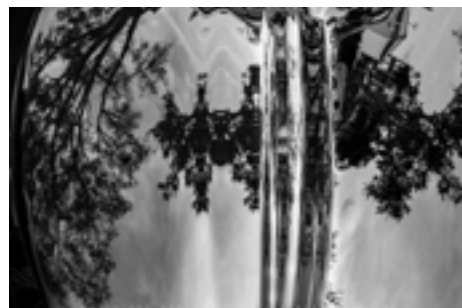
Pack a lunch and we will meet in the picnic area after the shoot.
