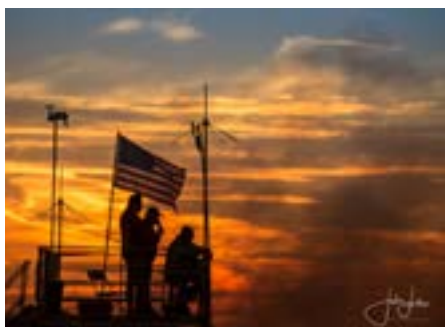
# SHOOT-OUT- April

For those who know they will be going, it's best to get advance tickets from the website and save time in line. However, anyone can make up their mind to go at the very last minute since tickets are always available at the gate.

First thing on arrival at noon is to take your lawn chairs over to the viewing field and leave them there. Arrive early to get your chair in front for best viewing and photography.

The taxiway is right in front of the field and all aircraft pass by going and coming from the runway. ### Annual Chertok Nature Photo Contest

Orange Audubon Society's (OAS) 2018 Kit and Sidney Chertok Florida Native Nature Photography Contest, is themed: Florida Native Nature and has a deadline of April 19, 2018 (postmarked by date).

This 30th annual contest is open to all photographers (except members of OAS' board and Chertok contest committee) and there are three skill level competition categories: Youth—for photographers age 17 or younger by April 19, 2018; Novice—for new and less experienced photo hobbyists; and Advanced Amateur/ Professional—for experienced photographers who have practiced and honed their skills over time.

Eligible photos may not include humans, human artifacts or introduced plant or animal species—subject matter must be native to Florida—and entries must be taken in compliance with the NANPA code of conduct. Participants will be notified of any disqualified entries and may optionally replace them at no charge. See contest rules for details. Again this year , Tarflower Chapter of Florida Native Plant Society will add \$100 in NEW cash prizes for 1st–3rd place Youth winners. Together with OAS and co-sponsor Colonial Photo & Hobby's cash and other prizes, the total prize package is valued at \$1,200. Entries in all categories that are taken on Orange County natural lands (Green PLACEs) are eligible to be included in Orange County's nature calendar. Entry submission details are on the OAS website. So get outside with your cameras and start shooting and preserving Florida's amazing native nature!
