MEMBER SPOTLIGHT: MARK POLLITT

I came to Orlando, as a part-time resident in 2005 and I continue to split my time between Maryland and Florida. I have been an OCC member for a number of years and joined after meeting many of the members at my "other job" as a Volunteer at the Orlando Wetlands Park. I have been impressed with the talent, enthusiasm, and openness of the members and try to make as many meetings as work and travel will allow. I learn something at every club event!

I have been shooting since my high school days, when I did photomicrography and some yearbook sorts of things. I bought my first 35mm SLR when I went overseas in the military and started doing travel and aviation photography. After ten years as a military pilot, I joined the FBI and continued my photographic journey with some great foundational courses in crime scene and surveillance photography. The former can be a bit



grim and neither are particularly "artistic," but they both require understanding the principles and good technique. But we did get to "play" with some very high-end Nikon gear! After I got promoted out of hands-on investigations, I started travelling extensively for work. Digital cameras were just coming out and I spent spare time on trips working on my travel photography. I have travelled to, and photographed, over 100 countries and all seven continents. After retiring from the FBI, I became a college professor and added wildlife photography to my interests. Working out at the Orlando Wetlands Park is a fabulous place to grow your skills and knowledge, not just for wildlife, but landscape, nature, and macro photography. Since the pandemic, I have started doing some urban street and mural photography. I shoot entirely for pleasure, as it is for my personal expression and growth.

IMPORTANT CHANGE TO DIGITAL IMAGE SI7ING.

Change to rules: Participants must reduce the size of their digital submissions to 1024 Pixels on the longest side (1 Mb maximum image size).

Reason: Members used to be required to reduce images to 4500 pixels (then the website software would reduce it further to 1024 Pixels) however due to changes by the Website Software Manufacturer, this function no longer exists and therefore members must now do this instead.
