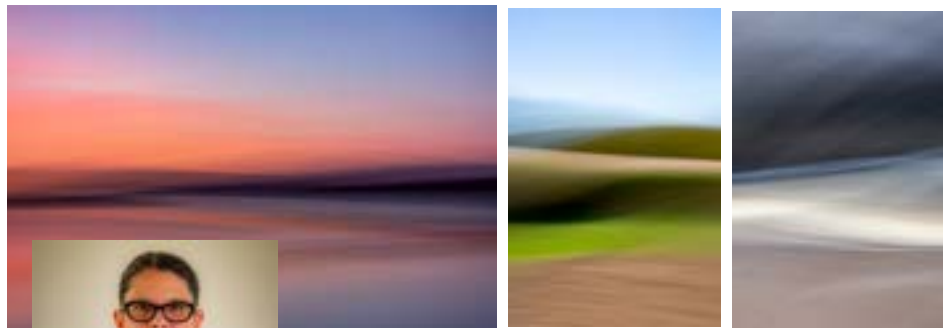

Stephanie Johnson presents:
The Art and Beauty of Intentional Camera
Movement (ICM) Photography**



Stephanie Johnson is an ICM and Landscape Photographer, and in her presentation "The Art and Beauty of Intentional Camera Movement (ICM) Photography" she shares her ICM work and talks about her journey from traditional

landscape photographer to focusing primarily on ICM photography. Stephanie has a deep love, joy, and passion for the individually expressive nature of ICM and encourages photographers to 'see things differently' through the lens of their cameras, as well as through the lens of their inner creative selves.

ICM photography allows photographers to express their creativity uniquely through the making of images that reveal it is not necessary to travel to all the iconic grand-scale landscapes in order to create beautifully artistic work with the camera.

'The Art and Beauty of ICM Photography' is that, by seeing things differently, we can connect with the ordinary, and even the mundane, to transform how we interact with our surroundings...to explore, experiment, and play with the camera in exciting new ways, resulting in images that are unique to each individual photographer.

In this talk, Stephanie covers some of the basic ICM principles and techniques, alongwith sample images to show the effects of various camera movements and thecamera settings for each. Additionally, several examples showing scenes before andafter using ICM will be shared, and a short field work video to show some of thecamera movements Stephanie uses in different location settings. Stephanie will also talk about her ongoing global ICM project, ICM Photography Magazine, and how this project and its extensions are celebrating ICM photographers and bringing awareness to the art of ICM around the world.

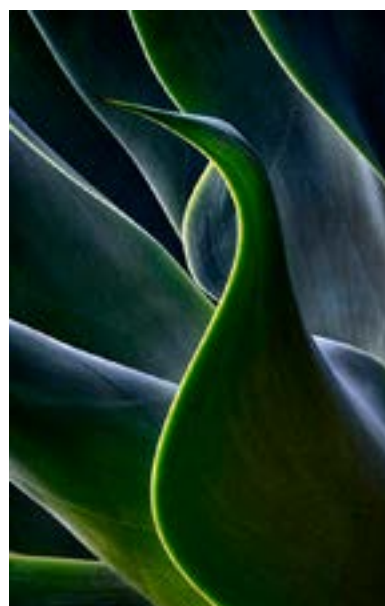

Submit an Entry for the 2023 Historic Preservation Calendar

Do you want to submit an entry for the 2023 Historic Preservation Calendar?

The photos in each Historic Preservation Board Calendar are selected from submissions from community residents as part of a photo competition.

The 2023 Historic Preservation Board Calendar will focus on Orlando's Park Lake/Highland Neighborhood.

Submissions must be postmarked by July 11, 2022 at 5 p.m.

Mail

Step 1. View this year's theme

To be eligible for the calendar, subject matter should be from structures that are at least 50 years old (generally, pre-1970).

Learn more about the theme

Step 2. Submit your photos

Participants can submit **up to three photographs**. Label on the back with your name, daytime telephone number, email address and the address of the subject site. Send photographs to:

Photographs must be black and white and printed on 8" x 10" or 8 1/2" X 11" photo paper with a white border. Vertical or horizontal photographs are acceptable.

Submitted photographs become the property of the City of Orlando Historic Preservation Board for use in the annual calendar competition and associated promotions.

Step 3. We will review submissions

Winning photos will be selected by members of the Historic Preservation Board through blind judging.

A \$100 honorarium will be awarded to each photographer whose picture is selected for the 2023 Historic Preservation Board Calendar, sponsored by McCoy Federal Credit Union. Winners will be notified by email.

2023 Historic Preservation Calendar Theme

The 2023 Historic Preservation Board calendar and photography competition will focus on Orlando's Park Lake/Highland neighborhood.

The Park Lake/Highland area comprises more than one historical subdivision with the majority of plats filed in the 1910s by County Surveyor and City Engineer Samuel Robinson. Original homeowners included Orlando's early businessmen who engaged prominent local architects to design their dwellings. A variety of styles reflecting architectural trends from the early- to mid-twentieth century are represented in the district including Bungalow, Colonial Revival, Contemporary, Craftsman, Dutch Colonial Revival, French Eclectic, Italian Renaissance Revival, Mediterranean Revival, Minimal Traditional, Mission, Monterey, Neoclassical Revival, Prairie, Ranch, and Tudor Revival.

The Park Lake/Highland Neighborhood is bordered by Virginia Drive to the north, Mills Avenue to the east, Colonial Drive to the south and Highland Avenue to the west. Please see the map for exact boundaries.

Submission subjects can be of individual details or an entire structure. Exterior or interior images of the subject will be accepted.

To be eligible for the calendar, subject matter should be from structures that are at least 50 years old (generally, pre-1970) and be located within the Park Lake/Highland neighborhood.
